2. Am I required to participate in the CCP Program?

Our CCP Policy states that Practicing and Restricted license SSOT members are required to participate in the CCP as part of the regular renewal process. Student, Life, Temporary (3 month), Non-Practicing SSOT members, and initial registrants are exempt from participating in the CCP.

3. I switched positions part way through the year; do I have to make new goals?

If a member's goal(s) becomes irrelevant or unattainable within the year, the member is required to establish alternate goal(s) and provide evidence for this goal. The member must update their PDPO, but this does not need to be submitted to SSOT until renewal.
