Dr. Joanne Kappel is a Clinical Professor of Medicine, University of Saskatchewan and Nephrologist with the Saskatchewan Health Authority. She is currently Clinical Professor of Medicine, Head Division of Nephrology for the College of Medicine and Dyad Co-Lead for Kidney Health Services, Saskatoon Health Region. She is also the Medical Director for the Chronic Kidney Disease Program, Saskatoon Health Region.

Dr. Elizabeth Sellers is a Professor, Department of Pediatrics and Child Health, University of Manitoba. As a clinician and clinical researcher, her primary focus is the epidemiology, pathophysiology, complications, treatment and, support of youth with Type 2 diabetes with a particular interest in Indigenous populations. Dr. Sellers works with the interprofessional team at the Diabetes Education Resource for Children and Adolescents in Winnipeg.

Dr. Jill Newstead-Angel completed a clinical fellowship in Obstetric Medicine in Rhode Island, USA as part of her 2 year General Internal Medicine fellowship. Her area of expertise is medical disorders in pregnancy with a special interest in Diabetes in Pregnancy. She is the medical lead for the Diabetes and Pregnancy Program in Saskatoon. She also manages hypertension in pregnancy and works closely with her Maternal-Fetal Medicine colleagues.
