COURSE DESCRIPTION

During this one day workshop, the instructor uses videos and group discussion to educate the participants about the administrative and scoring guidelines of the Chedoke-McMaster Stroke Assessment (CMSA). Lectures include information about the measure's development and psychometric properties and its clinical application. At the end of the workshop, the scoring competency of the participants is tested. Those who meet the scoring criterion will receive a certificate of scoring competency. All participants will receive written feedback regarding their performance on the test. These are distributed within four to six weeks after the workshop.

LEARNING OBJECTIVES

- To provide the participants with the opportunity to learn to use the measure as a clinical or research assessment tool
- To educate the participants about the administrative and scoring guidelines of the Chedoke-McMaster Stroke Assessment
- To educate the participants about the measure's development and psychometric properties, and its clinical application
- Assess each participant's competency in administering the assessment through a written examination
