Occupational Therapist Employment Opportunity

The Meadow Lake Tribal Council is seeking a dynamic individual to fill the full time or contracted position of Occupational Therapist for the Office of Education. This position is based on a 200 day school year contract with the possibility of contract renewal based on fiscal year funding. The successful candidate will work closely with individuals who have special needs to improve their skills, promote independence and he/she will provide creative strategies, adapt activities, prescribe equipment, and work in health promotion.

Roles and Responsibilities:

- The role is to provide consultative services to community health nurses, parents, classroom teachers, educational assistants, special education teachers, principals and administration.
- Assess individuals with formal and informal measures to determine area of strengths and areas that are challenging.
- Create reports which provide recommendations to the home or school based team which may include (but not limited to): adapting activities, providing equipment, creating individualized programming and making suggestions to improve the learning/home environment.
- Provide consultation to individuals/caregivers/staff as needed. Support the team that works one-on-one with individual(s) to improve skills in specific areas.
