### **Your Opportunity:**

It is an exciting time to be an Occupational Therapist with Alberta Health Services! We are expanding our services in Seniors Health and with this comes an opportunity to expand your skillset to a new level. We are looking for an experienced Occupational Therapist to join our teams in Grande Prairie, St. Paul and Barrhead. As an Occupational Therapist I (OT I) with the Seniors Complex Care Support Team (CCST), you will be a member of a mobile interdisciplinary team providing consultation services to caregivers in the management of the adults with cognitive/mental health/behavioural problems who will be cared for in the Continuing Care Stream. By using a patient- and family-centered care approach, you will work with local clinicians and other CCST members to provide specialized assessment, care plan recommendations and follow-up to patients. As an OT I, you will provide coaching and education to other team members in order to build capacity in the care of patients with complex behavioral needs. There is a strong focus on multidisciplinary and collaborative processes. As an OT I, you will arrange meetings, assessments, additional referrals when required, and liaise with representatives in Continuing Care, Home Care, Acute Care, Addiction and Mental Health, community agencies and others as needed for assessment and care planning. You will use information gathered from direct care staff to identify system and client specific barriers, and provide leadership in system navigation. Travel within North Zone may be required. In addition to a competitive rate of pay, AHS currently has a Remote Retention Allowance in place to an annual maximum of \$3,000. This allowance is non-pensionable and is payable on an hourly basis for all hours paid at the basic rate of pay.
