Navigating the Present, Preparing for the Future: Tricks of the Trade by Havelin Anand: OTs excel in promoting the strengths and needs of their clients, yet many feel ill-prepared to do this for themselves with their administrators, their colleagues, within their teams and communities. Havelin will help Saskatchewan OT's discover their potential to advocate for themselves and the profession. Topics during the two-day conference include:

Havelin Anand is Director of Government Affairs and Policy at CAOT. Her role is to increase knowledge and raise awareness about occupational therapy through advocacy initiatives on behalf of CAOT and occupational therapists with governments and public servants. She supports CAOT chapters and provincial occupational therapy associations in their advocacy efforts and represents CAOT in national coalitions. Prior to joining CAOT, Havelin was with the Federal Public Service for 40 years and enjoyed roles at the Director and Director General levels.
