Occupational Therapists, work and collaborate within a Clinical Services team of multidisciplinary professionals, (Occupational Therapists (OT), Physical Therapists (PT), Nurses, Behavioural Consultants, and support staff), and other professionals and stakeholders.

To qualify, an OT professional candidate must be registered or eligible for registration in the Saskatchewan Society of Occupational Therapists and be registered or eligible for membership with the Canadian Association of Occupational Therapists. Experience working with individuals in the areas of intellectual disability, mental health and or Sensory Processing Disorders is considered an asset, but we provide opportunities to build this skill set.
