The Senior Therapists provides coaching, mentoring and guidance to staff therapists and other team members.

Qualifications:

Education:

Minimum requirement is a baccalaureate degree in Occupational therapy from a program which is recognized by the Canadian Association of Occupational Therapists; Must be licensed by the Saskatchewan Society of Occupational Therapists and be eligible for membership in the Canadian Association of Occupational Therapists.

Experience:

The senior level position would require the incumbent to have a minimum of two (2) years related experience.
